

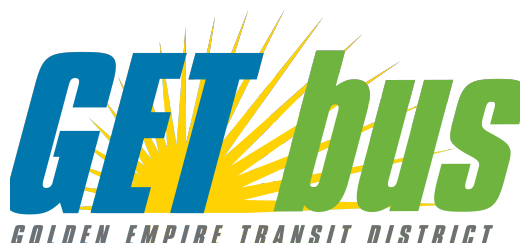


Within the scope of the EMS, the District will:
