Director Parra shared that Bike Bakersfield's Christmas Ride would be on Monday, December 20<sup>th</sup>. They will also have an outreach workshop on Wednesday. She asked if the new, smaller footprint bus shelters would be installed before summer. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.
